
FREE TRAINING TO BECOME A PROFESSIONAL CAREGIVER

The Surrey Academy provides flexibly scheduled, free training to individuals who want to become direct caregivers for older adults.

PROGRAM INCLUDES

- Online e-learning (32 hours)
- Classroom discussion and in person skills learning (8 hours)
- Supervised internship working with individuals in the field (20 hours)
- Help reviewing for the 57-question competency exam that qualifies candidates to work as a direct care worker in the state of Pennsylvania
- Administration of the exam

To apply, candidates must have the following:

- Be at least 18 years of age
- Have 1 year of satisfactory verifiable work experience
- Be eligible to legally work in the United States
- Have a current PPD, chest x-ray or blood test
- Have a Criminal Background Check (FBI clearance if you have lived in PA less than 3 years)
